TWIN CITIES AUTO SHOW TO FEATURE THREE HISTORIC FORD GTS

March 9 – 17 at the Minneapolis Convention Center

Minneapolis (March 6, 2019) --- The Twin Cities Auto Show presented by Speedway®, in partnership with Ford Performance, announces a historic first for *any* auto show – a display of three historic Ford GTs.

The 46th annual Twin Cities Auto Show will roll into the Minneapolis Convention Center March 9 – 17, 2019. During the entire show, all three historic Ford GTs -- a 1968 GT40, a 2006 GT, and an all-new custom 2018 -- will be on display in the Luxury Ballroom.

Painted in racing's most famous color scheme, Gulf Oil Blue and Orange, these cars honor the 50th anniversary of the Ford GTs historic 1969 victory at Le Mans.

In June 1966, three Ford GT40s crossed the finish line of the 24 Hours of Le Mans in a 1-2-3 result, fulfilling Henry Ford II's dream of beating Ferrari, who had won the previous six years in a row. The Ford GT40 team would find themselves at the top of the podium again in 1967, 1968, and 1969.
